CALLED BY GOD; THE GREAT I AM.

I don't know how you respond to God but as we fast and pray. May we take Isaiah's posture as something to emulate. Confronted by God's holiness Isaiah became aware of his own sinfulness. The majesty, splendor and authority of God made Isaiah faint in need of God.

Isaiah 6:1-5 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a high and lofty throne, and the train of his robe filled the temple. **2** In attendance above him were seraphim.**[b]** Each of them had six wings: with two they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with the third pair they flew. **3** And they called out to one another,

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts.

The entire earth is filled with his glory."

4 The voices of those who called out shook the thresholds, and the temple was filled with smoke. **5** Then I said,

"Woe is me! I am doomed.

For I am a man of unclean lips,

and I live among a people of unclean lips,

yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts."

SURRENDER FOR YOUR CONSECRATION



It's only through knowing who God is that we truly view ourselves in the right light. Without this revelation we as humans love to worship ourselves. Today we need to dethrone ourselves and enthrone God through consecration and repentance.

Isaiah 6:6-7 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, holding in his hand a burning coal that he had removed from the altar with a pair of tongs. **7** He touched my mouth with it and said,

"Now that this has touched your lips,

your guilt has been removed

and your sin has been blotted out."

I. Come in repentance. Ask the Lord to cleanse your lips for right speech and right confession.

Ezekiel 16:49-50 Behold, this was the guilt of your sister Sodom: she and her daughters had arrogance, abundant food and careless ease, but she did not help the poor and needy. **50** Thus they were haughty and committed abominations before Me. Therefore, I removed them when I saw it.

II. Repent from pride and self-worship, remove idols away from you (whatever the Spirit lays on your heart)

Judges 6:25-27 Now that same night the Lord said to him, "Take your father's spare ox, the ox that is seven years old. Break down the altar to Baal that belongs to your father, and cut down the Asherah that is beside it. **26** Build a proper altar to the Lord, your God, on top of this rock. Offer up the spare ox as a burnt offering, using the wood from the Asherah you cut down."

27 So Gideon took ten of his servants and did what the Lord had told him to do. Because he was afraid of his father's household and the men of the city, he could not do it during the day; he did it at night.

III. Repent by denouncing ungodly family and national altars.

John 17:15-18 15 My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. 17 Sanctify them by[a] the truth; your word is truth. 18 As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world.

IV. Repent of the stubbornness & the unwillingness of the Church to be the sent of the Lord.

RECOGNIZE, THE MAKING THROUGH THE BREAKING PROCESS



God knows what's good for us. **Ephesians 2:10** "For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we should walk in them.

Hosea 6:1-3 "Come, let us return to the Lord; for he has torn us, that he may heal us; he has struck us down, and he will bind us up. Let us know; let us press on to know the Lord; his going out is sure as the dawn; he will come to us as the showers, as the spring rains that water the earth."

I. The hardships, sufferings, trials and challenges we've faced have been to remove distractions from our lives. That we may be cleansed and refined and set apart for God.

II. Pray that in all these things, we will truly know Him. Truly know His name and find our rest in His presence in complete trust in Him.

Ezekiel 3:18-19 When I say to a wicked person, 'You will surely die,' and you do not warn them or speak out to dissuade them from their evil ways in order to save their life, that wicked person will die for their sin, and I will hold you accountable for their blood. **19** But if you do warn the wicked person and they do not turn from their wickedness or from their evil ways, they will die for their sin; but you will have saved yourself.
